Luke 5:4-5

“When (Jesus) had finished speaking, he said to Simon, Now go out where it is deeper, and let down your nets to catch some fish.”

“Master, Simon replied, we worked hard all last night and didn’t catch a thing. But if you say so, I’ll let the nets down again.”

He **MEETS** us where we are AND...

He **TAKES** US where we’ve never been!

“We are pressed on every side by troubles, but we are not crushed. We are perplexed but not driven to despair. We are hunted down, but never abandoned by god. We get knocked down, but we are not destroyed.

YES = Where our faith meets Jesus’ faithfulness!

Luke 5:6-9

“And this time their nets were so full of fish they began to tear! A shout for help brought their partners in the other boat, and soon both boats were filled with fish and on the verge of sinking. When Simon Peter realized what had happened, he fell to his knees before Jesus and said, Oh, Lord, please leave me – I’m too much of a sinner to be around you. For he was awestruck by the number of fish they had caught, as were the others with him.”

Question: What is the 2” domino you need to push over—the place where Jesus is saying, “Trust me?”

I’ve heard it said that “we tend to overestimate what we can do in a year... but we underestimate what God can do in 10 or 20 years!”

Eugene Peterson calls it – “A long obedience in the same direction!”

Application:

Where is God asking you to trust Him today?

Where is he asking you to follow Him into deeper waters?
