Romans 1:18-20 ESV

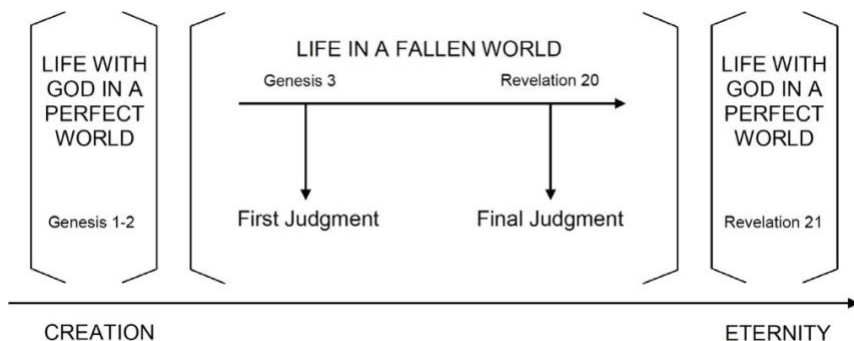

So they are without excuse.

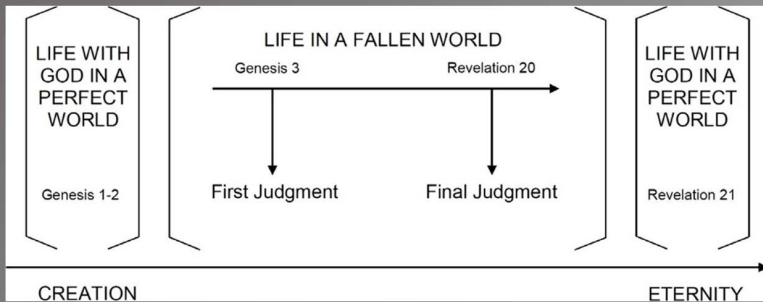
