Love is more powerful than any force coming against you. Romans 8:35-36

- Troubles are not a thermometer for how much God loves you.
- Circumstances cannot accurately reflect God's love for you.

God's love can empower you to conquer your circumstances.

What is the absolute proof that God loves you unconditionally?



Application:


