Amazing gratefulness will make you amazingly generous.


Big Idea: Generosity is a spiritual discipline that requires sacrifice and a plan.

#### The Plan

1 Cor 16:2-3 On the first day of every week, each one of you should set aside a sum of money in keeping with his income, saving it up, so that when I come no collections will have to be made.

#### The Promise

2 Cor 9:11 You will be made <u>rich in every way</u> so that you can be <u>generous on every occasion</u>, and through us your generosity will result in thanksgiving to God.
