Psalm 139 Steve Holdaway, LifeSpring Church, 03.17.24

Psalm 139:1-6 (NIV)

O LORD, you have searched me and you know me. You know when I sit and when I rise; you perceive my thoughts from afar. You discern my going out and my lying down; you are familiar with all my ways. Before a word is on my tongue you know it completely, O LORD. You hem me in-- behind and before; you have laid your hand upon me. Such knowledge is too wonderful for me, too lofty for me to attain.

God knows everything about you. 1-6 (Quit pretending.)

Apply: The omniscience of God should do two things in your life:

- 1) Cause you to quit pretending and come clean, and,
- 2) Cause you to call out to him, knowing that he understands your situation, signature sins, and brokenness—yet he still loves you enough to receive you.

God Is with you constantly. 7-12 (Quit running.) Psalm 139:7-12

7 Where can I go from your Spirit? Where can I flee from your presence? 8 If I go up to the heavens, you are there; if I make my bed in the depths, you are there...

God ordained your birth, death, and opportunities. (13-16)

(Quit worrying.)

13 For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb.14 I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well...

God is the Sovereign Avenger. (19-24) (Quit scheming.)

19 If only you would slay the wicked, O God! Away from me, you bloodthirsty men! 20 They speak of you with evil intent; your adversaries misuse your name...

23 Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. 24 See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.

You discern my going out and my lying down; you are familiar with all my ways. Before a word is on my tongue you know it completely, O LORD.


