## RECIPE OF THE MONTH Peanut Butter and Jelly Bars

#### **Ingredients**

- 2 cups peanut butter
- 1/2 cup unsalted butter
- 3/4 cup honey
- 2 large eggs
- 1 teaspoon vanilla

#### Instructions

- 3 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1 teaspoon kosher salt
- 1 cup jelly (any flavor)
- 1/2 cup mini chocolate chips



- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Grease a 9x13-inch baking pan with cooking spray or line with parchment paper; set aside.
- In the bowl of an electric mixer fitted with paddle attachment, combine the peanut butter, butter and honey. Beat on medium speed until light and fluffy. Add the eggs and beat until well combined. Beat in the vanilla.
- 3. In a separate bowl, whisk together the flour, baking powder and salt. With the mixer on low speed, slowly add the flour mixture until well combined and a thick dough forms.
- 4. Transfer 2/3 of the dough into the prepared baking dish. Press down evenly with your hands or spatula. Spread the jelly evenly over the peanut butter mixture. Crumble the remaining 1/3 of the dough evenly over the jelly. Sprinkle with chocolate chips.
- 5. Bake until golden, about 30 minutes. Let cook completely before cutting into bars.
