We believe that our relationship with Christ can only be truly healthy when we are in <u>daily communication</u> with the Lord. We know that the prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective. We also believe that prayer is <u>essential</u> in knowing the mind of Christ, His guidance in our lives, in the confession of our sin, in keeping us from temptation, and in receiving both the Lord's power and blessings in our lives and the life of our church.

WHY IS DAILY PRAYER ESSENTIAL?

1. Because God Supplies the Daily Bread I Need!

"Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name, Your kingdom come, Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. <u>Give us today our daily bread</u>. Forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. And lead us not into temptation but deliver us from the evil one. Matthew 6:9-13 NIV

2. Because I don't know the Problems, Pain or Predicaments in My Future "One day Jesus was praying in a certain place. When He finished, one of His disciples said to Him, 'Lord, teach us to pray..." Luke 11:1 NIV
