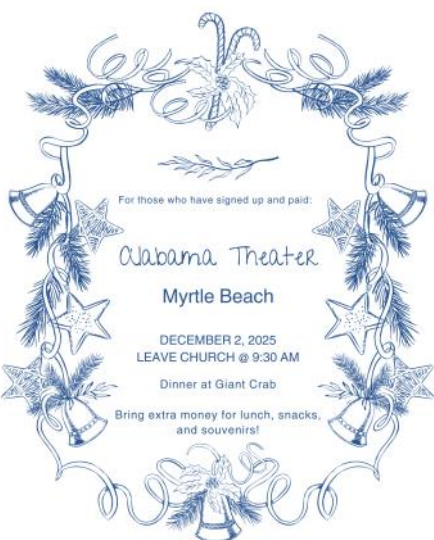

Thank You For Packing Backpacks for Appalachian Christmas Outreach:

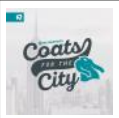
FBC Ladies fixed 5 Backpacks. Thanks to each of you!

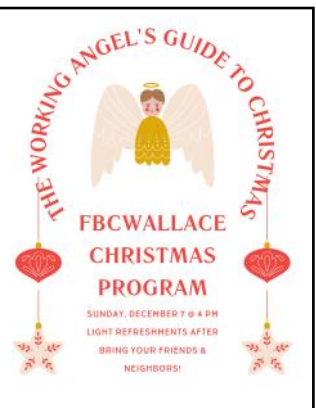
Thank You For Participating in Touch-A-Truck:

Changes for Wallace Kids Beginning in January:

Wallace Kids grades 1st-5th: The kids will remain with their family in the sanctuary every month that has a 5th Sunday.

A Check-In station will be at the intersection of the WK wing. The WK leaders for the older kids will man the station on their designated Sundays to teach. There will be a list of our current members, and there will be space to add children as well. Family Cards will be made for each family represented. This will be given to parents as they check in their child(ren). Parents/designated person(s) will sign the children out at pick up.

Nursery: Nursery workers need to be in place no later than 9:10 am. Check-In for Nursery aged children (infant up to 3yrs old) will begin at 9:15 am. Parents will receive a "Family Card" with names of parents and child(ren) and contact number. Name tags will be placed on diaper bags, cups, etc. for identification purposes. Parents need to fill out an information sheet to be placed in the Nursery Notebook if they have not previously done so. The Family Card will be presented at time of pick up.

3 yr. old-Kindergarten: Check-In begins at 9:15 am. They will go to their class and begin their activities and lesson. Parents will present the Family Card at time of pick up.

Grades 1st-5th: Parents need to check in their child(ren) beginning at 9:15 am. However, the children will go into the sanctuary for the music worship time. They will dismiss when indicated in the bulletin and will be accompanied by their WK leaders to their room. The Family Card will be presented at time of pick up.

The goal is to increase security for our children, and to decrease interruptions of the sermon/missed sermon time for parents, as some parents desire to accompany their children to their rooms. Hopefully this will be a smooth transition.
