TEACHING POINTS

June 28, 2026

“The Art of LOVING”

Matthew 22:37-40

But when the Pharisees heard that he had silenced the Sadducees with his reply, they met together to question him again. One of them, an expert in religious law, tried to trap him with this question: *“Teacher, which is the most important commandment in the law of Moses?”*

Jesus replied, *“You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind.”* [Deut. 6:5] *This is the first and greatest commandment. A second is equally important: ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.’* [Lev. 19:18] *The entire law and all the demands of the prophets are based on these two commandments.”*

- We live with a DOWNWARD SPIRAL of corrupted love.
- Our world is STARVING FOR TRUE LOVE!

A. Love GOD Above All

- God works from a FRAMEWORK of love!
- God loved you BEFORE you ever thought to love him back!
- Romans 5:8 – **But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.**
- 1John 4:9-10 – **God showed how much he loved us by sending his one and only Son into the world so that we might have eternal life through him. This is REAL LOVE—not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins.**

B. Love OTHERS as Yourself

- We don’t generate love but allow God’s love to SHINE THROUGH US!
- 1 John 2:9 – **If anyone claims, “I am living in the light,” but hates a fellow believer, that person is still living in darkness.**
- You are not the END USER of God’s love!

EPHESIANS 3:18-19

And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, may have power, together with all the Lord’s holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, and to know this love that surpasses knowledge—that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.
