# **LEVITICUS**

SERMON TITLE | A Seat At The Table SERMON TEXT | Leviticus 3

PREACHER | Wes Mckay DATE | September 7, 2025

- 1. Eating Together: Peace and Fellowship with God (Leviticus 3)
  - The peace offering is a meal that is divided between the Lord, the worshipper, and the priest (Leviticus 7).
  - The peace offering has similarities and notable differences from the burnt offering (Leviticus 1).
  - The dissection of the animal's parts in the peace offerings (3:3ff).
  - The peace offering is laid "on top of" the burnt offering (3:5).
  - The peace offering is a "food offering." God is not hungry or in need of anything. God's aseity (independent, self-sufficient; Psalm 50:7-13; Acts 17:24-25).
  - The recurrence of "fat." The best of the best. "All fat is the Lord's" (v. 17). See Leviticus 7:25; 1 Samuel 2:12 -17, 29
  - Do not "eat the blood" (v. 17). Why? Its symbol and purpose (Genesis 9:4; Leviticus 17:11, 14).
  - "Statute forever" and "in your dwelling places." Their obedience to this prohibition is not conditioned on time or place (Proverbs 15:3).
  - The peace offering recognizes and celebrates the joyful fellowship and peace Israel has with God in His presence through the way He has provided (i.e., atonement, sacrifices and offerings; Deuteronomy 27:4-7).
  - Temporary: Hebrews 10:4, 11

- 2. Peace and Fellowship with God through Christ
  - The Problem: No peace and fellowship with God because of sin. (Colossians 1:21; Romans 5:10; Philippians 3:18; John 3:36)
  - The Solution: Christ's atonement. (Romans 5:1, 10; Colossians 1:20; Ephesians 2:14)
  - The Benefit: Eternal peace and joyful fellowship with God through Christ. (Romans 8:1; Ephesians 2:13-16; 1 John 1:3)
  - The Future: A Meal (Revelation 19:6-9)

#### THE GOSPEL IS... -

**God.** God is the Creator & King of all things. He is perfectly holy, worthy of all worship and will punish sin. (Genesis 1:1, 1 John 1:5, Revelation 4:11, Romans 2:5-8)

Man. All people, though created good, have become sinful by nature. From birth, all people are alienated from God, hostile to God (we chose to reject God's rule and rule our own lives) and subject to the wrath of God. (Genesis 1:26-28, Psalm 51:5, Romans 3:23, Ephesians 2:1-3)

**Christ.** Jesus Christ, who is fully God and fully man, is the true King. He lived a sinless life, died on the Cross to bear God's wrath in the place of all who would believe in Him, and rose from the grave in order to give His people eternal life. (John 1:1, 1 Timothy 2:5, Hebrews 7:26, Romans 3:21-26, 2 Corinthians 5:21, 1 Corinthians 15:20-22)

**Response.** Because He is King, God commands everyone everywhere to repent of their sins, trust in Christ as the only King in order to be saved and live as though He is your King. (Mark 1:15, Acts 20:21, Romans 10:9-10)
