LEVITICUS

SERMONTITLE | Cleansed and Debt-Free SERMONTEXT | Leviticus 5:1-6:7

PREACHER | Wes Mckay DATE | September 21, 2025

Derek Tidball: "If the sin offering pictures sin as dirt that needs cleansing, the guilt offering pictures sin as debt that needs paying."

- 1. The Specifics of Sin: Examples of Sin (5:1-4; 5:14-19; 6:1-3)
 - Loving God and Loving Neighbor (Matthew 22:37-40)
 - Things that required a sin-offering (5:1-13): Perverting justice, touching unclean things, making rash oaths
 - Things that required a guilt-offering (5:14-6:7): "in any of the holy things", "things ought not to be done", deceiving or defrauding neighbor
 - Profile of Sin: "breach of faith", sin is ultimately against the Lord (Ps. 51:4)
- 2. The Components of Repentance: Confession, Restitution/Restoration (5:5-6; 5:14-16; 6:4-6)
 - The confession component (5:4-6)
 - Christine Palmer: "Confession reaches deeper than an admission of guilt; it owns responsibility for sin, acknowledges the Lord's righteousness, and yields to his sovereign rule to order our lives."
 - The restitution/restoration component (5:6, 16; 6:4-6)
 - Matthew 5:23-24; Luke 19:8-10
- 3. The Character of God: Gracious and Forgiving (5:7-13; 5:10,13,16,18; 6:7)
 - The Lord's gracious accommodation in atonement. (5:7-12)
 - The opportunity for forgiveness is not withheld because of economic status.
 - Exodus 34:6-7 on display in the offerings.
 - "He shall be forgiven": Promise, assurance, confidence.
 - The laws in Leviticus depict God as lawful, righteous, and holy but also as gracious, merciful, and forgiving.
 - Psalm 32:1-5; 1 John 1:9; Isaiah 53:10; Colossians 2:13-14

THE GOSPEL IS... -

God. God is the Creator & King of all things. He is perfectly holy, worthy of all worship and will punish sin. (Genesis 1:1, 1 John 1:5, Revelation 4:11, Romans 2:5-8)

Man. All people, though created good, have become sinful by nature. From birth, all people are alienated from God, hostile to God (we chose to reject God's rule and rule our own lives) and subject to the wrath of God. (Genesis 1:26-28, Psalm 51:5, Romans 3:23, Ephesians 2:1-3)

Christ. Jesus Christ, who is fully God and fully man, is the true King. He lived a sinless life, died on the Cross to bear God's wrath in the place of all who would believe in Him, and rose from the grave in order to give His people eternal life. (John 1:1, 1 Timothy 2:5, Hebrews 7:26, Romans 3:21-26, 2 Corinthians 5:21, 1 Corinthians 15:20-22)

Response. Because He is King, God commands everyone everywhere to repent of their sins, trust in Christ as the only King in order to be saved and live as though He is your King. (Mark 1:15, Acts 20:21, Romans 10:9-10)
