LEVITICUS

SERMON TITLE | Inauguration of the Priests & Worship
SERMON TEXT | Leviticus 9

PREACHER | David Morrison
DATE | October 12, 2025

1. The preparation for the sacrifices (vs 1 – 6)

- Reasons to prepare for worship:
 - So God's presence & glory would appear (Vs 4 & 6 and Exodus 29:43);
 - Out of obedience because the Lord had commanded it (Vs 6);
 - Because God desires and expects worship from His people.

2. The offering of the sacrifices (vs 7 – 21)

- This first formal worship service occurred on the 8th day; a day of new beginnings for Israel.
- Worship was officiated by the newly ordained High Priest – Aaron (Vs 8).
- These sacrifices were for atonement and purification of both priests and people (Vs 7).
- The order of sacrifices for the people was significant (vs 15 – 21)
 - Sin offering for cleansing
 - Burnt offering for dedication to God
 - Grain offering thanking God for provision
 - Peace offering providing peace and fellowship with God
- The specialness of the day did not mean the daily worship practices could be neglected (Vs 17)

3. The result of the sacrifices (vs 22 – 24).

- Because of the sacrifices, Aaron was able to pronounce God's blessing on the people.
- Atonement, purification, and ransom made God's holy presence possible
 - His glory & presence showed possibly from an extraordinary brightness of the pillar of cloud
 - His glory & presence showed by divine fire coming out to consume the sacrifices
 - God authenticated the new priesthood & the new worship with the revelation of His glory
- The people responded with joy and reverence because the Lord was in their midst.

THE GOSPEL IS...

God. God is the Creator & King of all things. He is perfectly holy, worthy of all worship and will punish sin. (Genesis 1:1, 1 John 1:5, Revelation 4:11, Romans 2:5-8)

Man. All people, though created good, have become sinful by nature. From birth, all people are alienated from God, hostile to God (we chose to reject God's rule and rule our own lives) and subject to the wrath of God. (Genesis 1:26-28, Psalm 51:5, Romans 3:23, Ephesians 2:1-3)

Christ. Jesus Christ, who is fully God and fully man, is the true King. He lived a sinless life, died on the Cross to bear God's wrath in the place of all who would believe in Him, and rose from the grave in order to give His people eternal life. (John 1:1, 1 Timothy 2:5, Hebrews 7:26, Romans 3:21-26, 2 Corinthians 5:21, 1 Corinthians 15:20-22)

Response. Because He is King, God commands everyone everywhere to repent of their sins, trust in Christ as the only King in order to be saved and live as though He is your King. (Mark 1:15, Acts 20:21, Romans 10:9-10)
