LEVITICUS

SERMONTITLE | Learning Holiness The Hard Way SERMONTEXT | Leviticus 10

- 1. Disobedience (10:1-3)
 - Nadab and Abihu, Exodus 24
 - "unauthorized fire", not what the Lord had commanded
 - In chapters 1-9, the Lord has commanded how He is to be approached and worshipped. He has been very clear with the people and the priests.
 - God sends fire to show His approval (9:24) and disapproval (10:2). Hebrews 12:28-29
 - Nadab and Abihu's deaths show just how serious it is to disregard the Lord's commands. (Acts 5:1-11)
 - The Lord will show Himself as set apart and glorious before the eyes of the priests and the people.

- 2. Duty (10:4-11)
 - Cleansing the tabernacle after Nadab and Abihu's deaths.
 - The priests are to refrain from certain practices.
 - The priests have the responsibility to distinguish and teach.

- 3. Dispute (10:12-20)
 - In vv. 12-15, the emphasis is on the priests eating the portion they are due of the offering.
 - Moses finds that they have not eaten what was prescribed!
 - Moses interrogates Aaron.
 - Aaron explains his reasoning, and his explanation is accepted.

THE GOSPEL IS... -

God. God is the Creator & King of all things. He is perfectly holy, worthy of all worship and will punish sin. (Genesis 1:1, 1 John 1:5, Revelation 4:11, Romans 2:5-8)

Man. All people, though created good, have become sinful by nature. From birth, all people are alienated from God, hostile to God (we chose to reject God's rule and rule our own lives) and subject to the wrath of God. (Genesis 1:26-28, Psalm 51:5, Romans 3:23, Ephesians 2:1-3)

Christ. Jesus Christ, who is fully God and fully man, is the true King. He lived a sinless life, died on the Cross to bear God's wrath in the place of all who would believe in Him, and rose from the grave in order to give His people eternal life. (John 1:1, 1 Timothy 2:5, Hebrews 7:26, Romans 3:21-26, 2 Corinthians 5:21, 1 Corinthians 15:20-22)

Response. Because He is King, God commands everyone everywhere to repent of their sins, trust in Christ as the only King in order to be saved and live as though He is your King. (Mark 1:15, Acts 20:21, Romans 10:9-10)
