SERMON TITLE | The Founder of Our Salvation
SERMON TEXT | Hebrews 2:10-13

PREACHER | Wes McKay

1. The Sufferings of Christ for His People (2:10)

- The necessity of Christ's sufferings. (Hebrews 7:26; Mark 8:31; 9:31; Acts 2:23)
- The orchestrator and goal of our salvation. (Hebrews 1:3; Romans 11:36; 1 Corinthians 8:6; Colossians 1:16)
- Christ is the founder of our salvation (Hebrews 12:2; 6:19-20).
- Christ being "made perfect"? Christ is qualified to serve as the leader, savior, and priest of our salvation.
- Harris: "Thus perfection in this verse does not suggest any existing imperfection, but rather the perfect completion of God's plan to redeem his people through the suffering of his Son."
- His sufferings are the qualifications for his service as our great high priest. (Hebrews 5:7-10; 7:28)

2. The Solidarity of Christ with His People (2:11-13)

- Christ our sanctifier. (Hebrews 13:12)
- We are the ones being sanctified.
- With Christ, we have a relationship with the Father.
- Christ, our brother. (Romans 8:29; Mark 3:32-35; Hebrews 2:17)
- The Old Testament passages that support this familial relationship.

THE GOSPEL IS...

God. God is the Creator & King of all things. He is perfectly holy, worthy of all worship and will punish sin. (Genesis 1:1, 1 John 1:5, Revelation 4:11, Romans 2:5-8)

Man. All people, though created good, have become sinful by nature. From birth, all people are alienated from God, hostile to God (we chose to reject God's rule and rule our own lives) and subject to the wrath of God. (Genesis 1:26-28, Psalm 51:5, Romans 3:23, Ephesians 2:1-3)

Christ. Jesus Christ, who is fully God and fully man, is the true King. He lived a sinless life, died on the Cross to bear God's wrath in the place of all who would believe in Him, and rose from the grave in order to give His people eternal life. (John 1:1, 1 Timothy 2:5, Hebrews 7:26, Romans 3:21-26, 2 Corinthians 5:21, 1 Corinthians 15:20-22)

Response. Because He is King, God commands everyone everywhere to repent of their sins, trust in Christ as the only King in order to be saved and live as though He is your King. (Mark 1:15, Acts 20:21, Romans 10:9-10)
