SERMON TITLE | REST
SERMON TEXT | Hebrews 4:1-11

PREACHER | Wes McKay
DATE | August 16, 2026

1. Fear, Lest We Fail to Enter The Rest (4:1-3a)

- “Therefore” connects 3:14-19 to 4:1-11
- The promise of rest still stands for God’s people.
- “Fear”- spiritual vigilance, attention, awareness.
- The danger we must fear is the failure to enter the rest.
- Hearing is not the problem; unbelief is.
- Galatians 3:8; Isaiah 6:9; Hebrews 3:12

2. The Final Rest for the People of God (4:3b-10)

- How does one enter the rest? Through faith.
- The author connects Psalm 95 to Genesis 2:2.
- Israel doesn’t enjoy the rest of Genesis 2:2.
- God’s people are awaiting a final rest. (Hebrews 11:16; Hebrews 12:22; Revelation 21:1-8)
- One benefit of the final rest is that we rest from our works.

3. Strive, Lest We Fail to Enter the Rest (Hebrews 4:11)

- In addition to fear, we must strive.
- The call to strive is a call to fight in the Christian life. (1 Timothy 6:11; 2 Timothy 4:7; 2 Peter 1:10; 2 Peter 3:14)
- What is the danger of failing to strive? What is the danger of spiritual passivity?

THE GOSPEL IS...

God. God is the Creator & King of all things. He is perfectly holy, worthy of all worship and will punish sin. (Genesis 1:1, 1 John 1:5, Revelation 4:11, Romans 2:5-8)

Man. All people, though created good, have become sinful by nature. From birth, all people are alienated from God, hostile to God (we chose to reject God’s rule and rule our own lives) and subject to the wrath of God. (Genesis 1:26-28, Psalm 51:5, Romans 3:23, Ephesians 2:1-3)

Christ. Jesus Christ, who is fully God and fully man, is the true King. He lived a sinless life, died on the Cross to bear God’s wrath in the place of all who would believe in Him, and rose from the grave in order to give His people eternal life. (John 1:1, 1 Timothy 2:5, Hebrews 7:26, Romans 3:21-26, 2 Corinthians 5:21, 1 Corinthians 15:20-22)

Response. Because He is King, God commands everyone everywhere to repent of their sins, trust in Christ as the only King in order to be saved and live as though He is your King. (Mark 1:15, Acts 20:21, Romans 10:9-10)
