ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNERS

Learning the language is an essential part of making your way in a new culture. Our ELL classes not only provide a path for people from all over the world to develop their English skills, but receive the love of Jesus through time spent with caring believers. A team of amazing volunteers supports a beginner, intermediate, and advanced class. In 2025, our advanced class saw particular growth. We introduced some students to their first traditional Thanksgiving meal, and at our Christmas party, the gospel was shared in two languages. We're encouraging our most advanced students to attend Engage or MANday Night for conversation and language immersion, where they can also engage in discipling relationships. Pray for continued growth in our students, and consider coming alongside these folks as they break new ground in both language and faith!



DEEP DISCIPLESHIP

RELATIONSHIPS ON MISSION

We believe that the main vehicle for discipleship is relationships. While Sunday large group services are a big part of learning and growing, it's in small groups that we can be known, know each other, and do the essential work of applying scripture to our lives in community. In keeping with our mission and core values, this year has seen more emphasis than ever on relational discipleship environments. In 2025 (as of this publication) around 100 people at Providence have participated taken part in DSI, a training weekend focused on learning to facilitate and participate in healthy, fruitful small groups. We've also sent teams to train 50 at Park Avenue Baptist Church in Titusville, Florida, and over 40 more in two Zimbabwe communities!





RE:GENERATION

In 2024, Providence had our pilot group for Regeneration—a biblically-based discipleship program offering healing, recovery, and freedom from any type of struggle. Eighteen people representing six churches completed the first group, with three becoming new leaders as Re:Gen continues at Providence. This is a focused environment for people to address specific struggles that can interfere with a life of full surrender to Christ. Participants say they grew in their understanding in God's word, became bolder in sharing their faith, pursued opportunities to serve, and developed a daily habit of being in God's word. Let's celebrate and praise God for his work through this ministry!



Providence is committed to making disciples who make disciples, and one of our primary goals is planting new churches that plant new churches. In 2025, we completed the launch phase of GreenHouse Church, sending out a team of dedicated leaders who have already embedded their lives in the Lenoir City community.



BRIDGE CHURCH (bridgeknox.com)

Providence sent out Bridge Church to be a ministry of reconciliation in the city of Knoxville, and they have now celebrated their seventh anniversary as a church! In 2025, they moved into a permanent location where they are building a strong presence and relationship in their community. In the coming year, pray for Bridge Church:

We've seen folks coming to faith and getting baptized, and welcomed several babies into the congregation (with more on the way). We've been joined by older people who bring with them the welcome ballast of wisdom and life experience, as well as college students and young families, with their optimism and energy. For the coming year, we would love your prayers that the Lord continues to work in us and through us as He has been, and that we continue to grow in the knowledge and love of Him.



REDEEM ALL MINISTRIES (RAM)

One thing that all cultures have in common is the centrality of relationships. This year, a team from Providence was blessed to work with Redeem All Ministries in Zimbabwe to lead DSI training with over 40 people from eight churches in the areas of Kachuta and Mhangura. Pray for the Mupesewa family - Anyway, Maegan, and their kids - who lead Redeem All Ministries. RAM works in Zimbabwe to share the gospel, train leaders, plant churches, and equip people in trades that can support their communities and ministries. THE TIMOTHY INITIATIVE (TTI)

Since 2007, The Timothy Initiative has supported the planting of new churches that make new disciples and plant new churches. Indigenous leaders - people being trained to lead and minister in their own culture and location - are at the heart of TTI's planting process. Providence supports TTI financially and personally, helping to reach the goal of a church in every village in Togo and Benin. TTI is also planting churches throughout Africa, Southeast Asia, and Mexico. Our 2026 budget will continue to support The Timothy Initiative as we pray and partner with them. 
