3. How did Aaron fail as a leader, and how can we avoid similar mistakes?
4. Moses was willing to stand against peer pressure and stand with God. How can we cultivate the courage to do the same in our daily lives?
5. What signs of spiritual or church decay need renewal, and how can we respond?
6. How does Moses' willingness to intercede for the Israelites reflect Christ's sacrificial love? In what ways are you called to intercede for those around you?
7. Do you seek human approval or God's approval in your leadership? How does it change your leadership and decisions?
8. What does the contrasting leadership styles of Moses and Aaron teach us about standing firm in difficult situations? How can we develop a "Moses-like" attitude?
9. How can you stand for God's truth when others pressure you to conform?
10. What's one way to surrender your leadership to Jesus today?
