## **PODS Discussion Questions**

1. What kinds of people might be identified as “Rahabs” today?
2. What does Rahab's story teach us about God's ability to use people from the most unlikely backgrounds?
3. How can we demonstrate to people that they are not beyond the reach of God's grace? What would it look like if we actively pursuing them with the salvation of Jesus?
4. How do you think Rahab had heard about the deeds of God? In what ways can fear of God lead us to genuine faith, as it did with Rahab?
5. How had Israel, even when they were wandering in the wilderness, served as witnesses to the power of God?
6. What did Rahab give up or risk to follow God?
7. What do you think is the most striking change in the person Rahab became compared to the person she was?
8. What does the change in Rahab tell us about the Gospel of Jesus? What are some “scarlet cords” that symbolize your trust or loyalty to Jesus today?
9. What step of action or obedience do you need to take as you consider how God's word has spoken to you?
10. How can your small group pray for you?
