Matthew 5:1-12 P.OD.S. Discussion Questions

- 1. What is your favorite beatitude, and why does it resonate with you personally?
- 2. What stood out to you, challenged you, or encouraged you from the sermon on Sunday?
- 3. Can you recall a time when you felt especially poor in spirit—a moment when you were acutely aware of your need for God? How did God meet you in that situation?
- 4. In 2 Corinthians 7:10, Paul discusses the difference between godly sorrow and worldly sorrow. What are the key distinctions? Can you share a personal experience where you encountered either type of sorrow?
- 5. As Christians, how do we demonstrate mercy without condoning sin? Do you believe the world sometimes confuses "mercy" with "tolerance"? Why or why not?
- 6. In what areas of your life would you like to grow in meekness? Is there a specific situation where you feel meekness is especially needed?
- 7. As you deepen in your faith, how have your desires begun to align more with God's desires?
- 8. Would you consider yourself a peacemaker? Why or why not? How can you actively promote peace at work, at home, or in the church?
- 9. What are some examples of Christian persecution happening in the United States today? How should we respond to these challenges?
- 10. Why do you think believers sometimes go through the motions of Christianity while their hearts are distant from God? What are some signs that a heart may be drifting away?
