Based on the message
“It Is I: Behold Christ, Be Sent”
by Shige Nakazawa

Opening:

1. In your life right now, what feels like a “headwind” against you?
2. When life becomes overwhelming, how does it usually affect your faith or your sense of hope?

Scene 1: Revelation in Trials: Beholding Christ (Mark 6:45-52)

3. Why do you think Jesus sent the disciples into this difficulty in the first place?
4. When do you find it hardest to recognize Jesus revealing Himself as the great I AM in the midst of your trials?
5. How does it encourage you to know that Jesus sees your struggles even before you see Him?

Scene 2: The Cross: Where Hardened Hearts Melt (Mark 15:37-39)

6. What does the cross reveal about the heart of God?
7. In what ways does reflecting on the cross lead you into deeper worship?

Scene 3: Isaiah’s Vision: Worship Generates Mission (Isaiah 6:1-8)

8. Why was Isaiah able to say, “Here I am! Send me!”?
9. What might it look like for you personally to say the same in your life right now?

Final Reflection

10. The message said: *“Behold Christ. Worship Christ. And you will be sent for Christ.”* Which part of this statement speaks most strongly to you right now?
