PODS Small Group Discussion Questions

1. What aspects of the sermon on the existence of God resonated with you the most, and what questions did it raise in your mind?
2. In your experience, what are some common reasons people abandon their belief in God? Have you ever faced moments of doubt in your faith?
3. Reflecting on the statement, "All of life is built on faith," what implications does this have for how we understand the beliefs of others, including atheists and agnostics?
4. How does the evidence presented for God's existence during the sermon strengthen your faith or change your perspective on your relationship with Him?
5. How confident do you feel in discussing the evidence for God's existence with others? What steps could you take to increase your confidence in these conversations?
6. In what ways can the evidence for God's existence empower you to share the gospel and tell your personal testimony of transformation?
7. Are you ready to share your story of transformation? In a nutshell, what is that story? (Reflect on the testimony in John 9:25 "I once was blind but now I see!")
8. What is one key takeaway you want to remember from this study, or what change do you want to make in your life?
