1. What challenged or encouraged you from Sunday's sermon?
2. Understanding Trust: In your own life, can you share a time when you had to trust God without fully understanding the situation? What did you learn from that experience?
3. Character of God: Pastor Carl emphasized that trusting God means knowing Him more and more. Which of God's characteristics resonates most with you, and how have they influenced your ability to trust Him during difficult times?
4. Decision-Making: Reflect on a recent decision you made. How did you involve God in that decision-making process? What steps did you take to acknowledge Him in your choices? How about sharing an experience when you did not include God?
5. Facing Uncertainty: How do you typically respond to uncertainty in your life? What practical steps can you take to trust God more fully when the future seems unclear?
6. Lessons from Abraham: Pastor Carl mentioned Abraham's challenges with trust. What parallels can you draw between Abraham's experiences and your own life when facing delays or challenges in receiving God's promises?
7. Trust and Obedience: Consider the great theology within the hymn "Trust and Obey." What does "trust and obey" look like in your day-to-day life? How can your PODS group support one another in aligning your wills with God's will?
