

Pressing On: Embracing Radical Faith

PODS Small Group Discussion Questions

Opener: What was your most important take away from Sunday's sermon?

Read Philippians 3:13-14, Joshua 4:1-9

1. What is “behind you” that tends to pull you back right now (shame/regret or the belief that God can't do anything with you)? What would it look like to press forward this week?
2. When have fear, doubt, or confusion tempted you to disobey God? What helped you choose obedience instead, and what will you do next time?
3. What is one specific time you clearly saw God's faithfulness in the past? How does that memory shape your faith for your current situation?
4. In Joshua 4:1–9, why did God command the people to build a memorial? What kind of reminder helps you trust God for the future?
5. Hebrews 11 describes people of faith. How does reading their stories affect your view of what God can do through ordinary people like you? Stop and read some of the stories from Hebrews 11.
6. In Joshua 6, faith involved listening to God and obeying Him. Where do you need to move from belief to obedience right now? How God's command to Joshua sound to you? And how do you think we struggle with God's commands today?
7. What is one action step you will take to press on with radical faith for real life this week?
