
#### SUNDAYS AT FLINT

"This study helped reveal the impact anxiety can have on our mental, physical, and spiritual health. I loved the chapters about Moses, David, and Jonah that compared to our feelings of failure and not being enough. So much encouragement and hope in this study!" – Valarie Hardy

"The Peace for the Anxious Heart study has helped me realize that a lot of my anxiety stems from the never-ending cycle of seeking the approval of others. I've been reminded that Jesus is the only one who offers us full and final acceptance. Only when I keep my focus on God's view of my worth can I find real peace."

Through honest conversation and biblical truth, women were reminded that lasting peace isn't found in circumstances but in Christ alone.

### ABIDING IN THE LIGHT - MEN'S RETREAT

"The content was very engaging and quite convicting and challenging. I had been delivered from a foul mouth when I was saved. The Lord cleaned me up and put me back in an environment in which I was able to keep a pretty pure vocabulary even in enemy territory. I had been listening to a number of podcasts and people that use pretty colorful language and it had begun rubbing off on me a little bit. During the course of the weekend, thinking about the theme, Abiding, I became very convicted of my foul language. God was convicting me that this is something that I needed to lay down. I spoke with one of the other guys in between sessions and he helped me work through that. It helped me see that perhaps I needed to lay down the podcast and get my vocabulary cleaned back up, so I can make sure I honor the Lord with my language." -Scott

"Prior to attending the event. I found out that my brother had passed away. I knew that I would be driving to meet family a few days following the retreat. However, I felt a strong desire to attend the retreat. It was as if God had put a huge desire in my heart to pray with and over other men. On Friday night after our first session, one of the men came to me and mentioned his struggles. It was at that point that I was able to spend a few minutes him praying with encouraging him in his walk with Christ. The overall experience and opportunity to spend this time in prayer with my brother in Christ made attending the retreat that much more special. To know that God laid on my heart to physically pray over and with other men was awesome. But to then get the chance to see it happen was a blessing that I was able to walk away with." -John

New York City - Christina Pope



On our first day, the Lord placed me beside a 17-year-old translator who shared her testimony and favorite story—David and Goliath. She connected with David's faith over fear and how God helps her face her own "giants." Later, when our VBS team couldn't find the planned lesson, she

Later, when our VBS team couldn't find the planned lesson, she joyfully told the children the story of David and Goliath, sharing how God used it in her life. The children listened intently, and it was clear God had arranged it all.

By week's end, nine women and several men accepted Christ as Savior. Thank you, church family, for your prayers—God truly answered!



#### Disaster Relief - Chad Lormand

The July 4th Hill Country tragedy left countless families devastated, but God quickly mobilized His people. The SBTC Disaster Relief teams deployed feeding units, chaplains, and clean-up crews to care for first responders and locals. Shower and laundry trailers were set up in multiple cities, and nearly 100 volunteers began the hard work of "mud-outs" in flooded homes.

Flint Baptist sent 10 of our own members, serving alongside others from across Texas in feeding, chaplaincy, assessing, and recovery. Despite challenges—including more flooding—our teams prayed with homeowners, distributed Bibles, and worked on a dozen homes. In the midst of tragedy, hope was shared, and the love of Christ was made known.

#### Kairos Prison Ministry, Michael Unit

"I was in prison and you came to visit me." Matthew 25:36 "The King will reply 'I tell you whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for Me.' Matthew 25:40

God chooses 42 men who are incarcerated in the Michael Unit to attend a Kairos weekend where they will experience God's light in the darkness of prison. He sends His servants, those He calls to obediently wash the feet of the 42 men by sharing God's love through structured talks, testimonies, fresh homemade meals, worship and prayers. We create a prayer chain of names of people who are praying for them, and this proves to be convicting. Each man receives about 35-40 hand written sealed letters from Kairos Michael Unit servants. These men are told that they are loved, and they are worthy of God's love, light and grace. No matter what they have done in their past, God forgives.


