FLINT KIDS SERVE

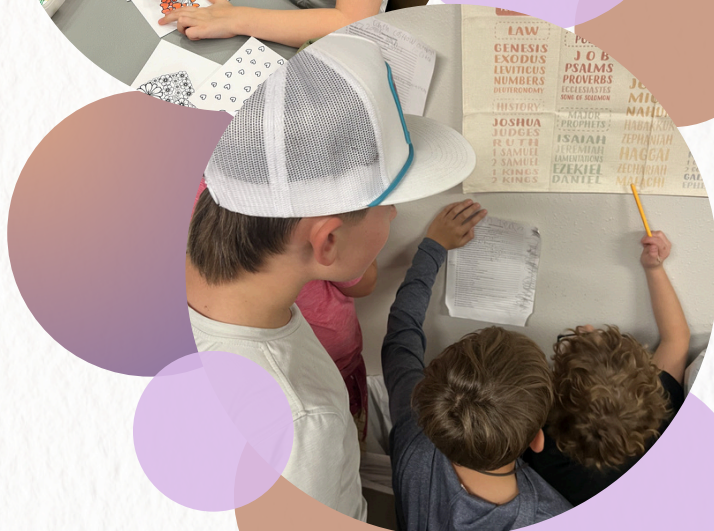

"It started during a time when I was getting a little older and beginning to ask more questions about my faith. So when I went to camp, I went with the mindset of wanting to get closer to the Lord.

During worship, something just felt different. I can't really explain it, but it did.

On the last day of camp, Miss Heather always meets with the oldest age group and we get to ask questions and talk about things. She was explaining how we can have the head knowledge about the Lord, but we also need to have it in our heart.

I realized in that moment that I definitely had the head knowledge. But I hadn't really made it personal in my heart.

As people were asking questions, I started to realize that Jesus really is my Savior, and that He went to the cross and died for us—even though He didn't have to.

So I asked, "How do I get saved?"

Miss Heather told me it's not about saying some special prayer. It's really about asking the Lord to come into your heart and admitting that you need Him to save you.

And that's when everything clicked for me.

THE PETERSON'S STORY

“Matthew and I both felt led to sign up for your programs this spring, thinking it would simply be a way to support something new you were offering. We had no idea how much we actually needed it.

When we joined The Five Love Languages small group, we thought we were already familiar—we had read the book together and even attended Dr. Gary Chapman's conference. But as we listened to others, answered questions, and worked through the homework, I began to realize how unloved I had been feeling for years.

At the start, we described our communication as “English/Spanish.” By the end, we discovered it was more like “English and Chinese.” It wasn't that my husband didn't love me—it was that we had been speaking completely different languages all along.

The book was helpful and the conference was great, but it was the small group and intentional work that truly made everything click and brought real change to our marriage.”

Cory Akin, a Flint member on staff with The Bucket Ministry, shared how Flint's heart for missions shaped his calling:

"Not sure words can express my thanks to Flint for being a gospel- and missions-minded church. 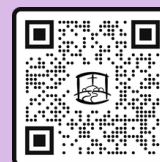
