### Key Responsibilities of Committee:

- Consistent with the Stewardship Committee's overarching goals, the Pledge Drive promotes and builds generosity at UUFH by conducting an annual all-member campaign.
- Maximize planned donations for the next Fellowship year
- Build committed relationships by fostering mission-focused engagement (winter pre-drive parties? Assigned direct asks?)
- Solicit and welcome Member feedback and supply to BOT via liaison
- Direct outreach to all Members
- Referrals to Minister, Care/Share, Pastoral Care as appropriate
- Honor leadership and high donors (Testimonials? Special private ask? Pre-canvass?)
- Creative messaging (theme/graphics)
- Extreme confidentiality
- Sunday Worship ministerial messaging during 4-6 week campaign duration
- Use of Fellowship database for tracking and confidential notes
- Stairstep chart to inspire next level giving
- Celebratory completion with congregational reporting
- Membership roster recommendations to BOT liaison regarding hardship underwriting, membership terminations, Emeriti designations
