Birthday Wishes of Long Island

Birthday Wishes of Long Island is a registered 501 (c) (3) nonprofit organization that was founded in 2009. Our mission is simple, but powerful: bring the joy of a birthday party to every child that needs it. We currently serve over 70 family homeless shelters, foster care children, and homeless teens through a partnership of school districts, court liaisons, and shelter staff. We celebrate over 150 birthdays per month. We provide birthday boxes – joyfully wrapped and filled with everything a child wants – paper goods, decorations, homemade cupcakes, and gifts specially chosen with their wishes in mind. In addition, Birthday wishes provides expectant mothers with a baby BIRTHday Bundle – a basket wrapped in a new bathtub filled with all the things a new mother would need. Birthday Wishes makes sure every homeless child knows that the day they were born is a day to be celebrated.
