


GROUP RIDING SAFETY RULES

- 1. <u>Ride your own ride</u>. Only ride according to your own capabilities. This includes, Speeding up to catch the rider in front of you, going faster than you feel comfortable with, passing a vehicle or pulling through an intersection. Remember that riding in a group doesn't mean that you surrender ANY decision making when it comes to safety.
- 2. The Leader of the ride will ride in the front left position of the group. This will always be an experienced rider. Another experienced rider should ride in the last position (sweep) and help the group if it gets separated or assist a rider in the event of a breakdown or accident.
- 3. We will ride in a staggered formation. Pick a stripe on the road or a sign on the side of the road, when the motorcycle directly in front of you passes it you can count "One one thousand, Two one thousand (2 seconds) before your front tire passes that same spot, this is a preferred safe distance.
- 4. <u>Make sure to leave enough space</u> so that each motorcycle can maneuver safely from side to side if need be.
- 5. <u>It is safer to ride tight</u> as our visibility to other motor vehicles is greater and there is less chance for a vehicle to cut into the middle of the group.
- 6. When coming to a stop tighten the formation to side by side to take up less space. Pull away from the stop allowing the formation to open back up. The leader of the ride (the motorcycle on the front left) will pull through the intersection first.
- 7. When passing, pass one at a time only as the road ahead is safe. Remember, RIDE YOUR OWN RIDE! You alone are responsible for your safety.
- 8. <u>If there is an opening</u> in the formation, simply pull forward. Do not swing side to side to fill the spot.
- 9. When riding on narrow roads or tight curves it may be best to ride in a single file.
- 10. <u>Trikes and sidecars</u> should stay in the center of the lane.
- 11. <u>Be familiar with and use</u> all the basic hand signals. (Please refer to the back side of this hand out for the proper hand signals)
- 12. <u>IMPORTANT!!!</u> BE SAFE & RIDE YOUR OWN RIDE!





