Leader: Join with me now to pray this prayer of humble confession.

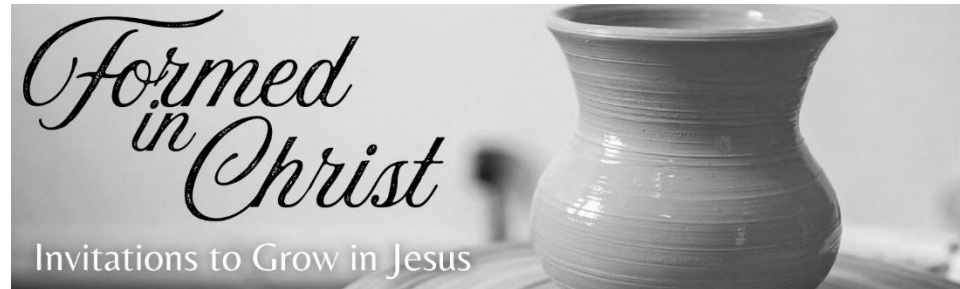
