WHAT IS?

WHATEVER IT TAKES

Whatever It Takes is a two-year discipleship journey to declare we are willing to do whatever it takes for all of Jones County to know Jesus.

Gray Community Church was built for a season like this, and you were uniquely designed for this moment in history. Our primary goal in this initiative is to build disciples by answering the question, **“Am I willing to do whatever it takes until all of Jones County knows Jesus?”**

The primary goal challenges each and every one of us to make significant next steps of obedience to what God is calling us into this next season.

This initiative is about:

Discipleship — becoming more like Jesus to live in freedom

Kingdom impact — seeing lives changed for decades to come

Multiplication — preparing to plant future churches and launch future leaders

Legacy — creating space for the next generation to worship, serve, and lead

The Whatever It Takes initiative is not about simply a dollar amount or a building. This initiative is about acting boldly in obedience, in sacrifice, and in faith daily until all of Jones County knows Jesus.

DISCIPLESHIP

The first and most important goal is that everyone would take a step of faith to participate in this journey, because we believe it will shape us all to be more like Jesus in faith and generosity. We believe God is more interested in what He's doing in us than what's being given by us.

So, this initiative is an invitation to grow in obedience, generosity, and trust. It's not about how much you can give financially but about being willing to ask the question: **"Lord, what would You have me do?"**

This is not about equal gifts. It's about equal surrender.

Your participation fuels:

- **The weekly ministry we're already doing** — worship, groups, outreach, serving, salvations, baptisms, families restored, students discipled
- **The momentum we're stepping into** — making room for more people to meet Jesus
- **The mission we act and speak by** — to help people know God and make God known

2. MULTIPLICATION

God has not only called us to grow and add to the kingdom, but He's called us to multiply his Church. That means raising up leaders, sending out planters, and building teams that can sustain long-term impact.

This initiative will help us:

- Hire a full-time Student Pastor to shepherd our growing next generation
- Raise up and send out a Church Planter to expand God's Kingdom beyond GCC
- Develop and disciple leaders who will carry the mission forward

3. LEGACY

It is time to move from portable to permanent. A permanent facility isn't about comfort, it's about creating a space for people to encounter Jesus week after week, generation after generation.

A home of our own will allow us to:

- Welcome more people with expanded seating and hospitality
- Create consistent spaces for kids and students to grow in their faith
- Host ministry and outreach events without the limits of rental logistics
- Root ourselves in the heart of the community for decades of local impact

Cost Breakdown:

\$500,000 purchase and \$2.5 million renovation and addition



WHAT WILL IT TAKE?

ONE CHURCH. ONE MISSION. ONE FUND.

We believe we're standing in a legacy defining moment.

This is our moment to move from **temporary** to **permanent**, from **planting** to **rooting**, and from **vision** to legacy.

This initiative is a **2 year discipleship** journey and commitment to do **whatever it takes** until all of Jones knows Jesus.

The total initiative will cost **\$2,250,000** over the next **24 months**.

This one-fund will allow us to continue kingdom advancement, step into greater multiplication, purchase the property debt free, and meet the minimum lending requirements of \$1,000,000 to renovate 217 Old Hwy 18.



HOW DO I KNOW WHAT TO GIVE?

This initiative isn't for a select few, rather it's for all of us. We're inviting everyone who calls GCC home to participate in faith, in joy, in sacrifice, and in unity.

A mission like this cannot be accomplished by a few persons, it will take everyone of us making the declaration, "Lord, I am willing to do whatever it takes until all of Jones County knows Jesus."

This is between you and the Lord. We never ask you to give a certain amount. You should give whatever He puts in your heart to give. Follow this path and let God be your guide.

LISTEN - Remain open to how He wants you to contribute to the growth of His Kingdom.

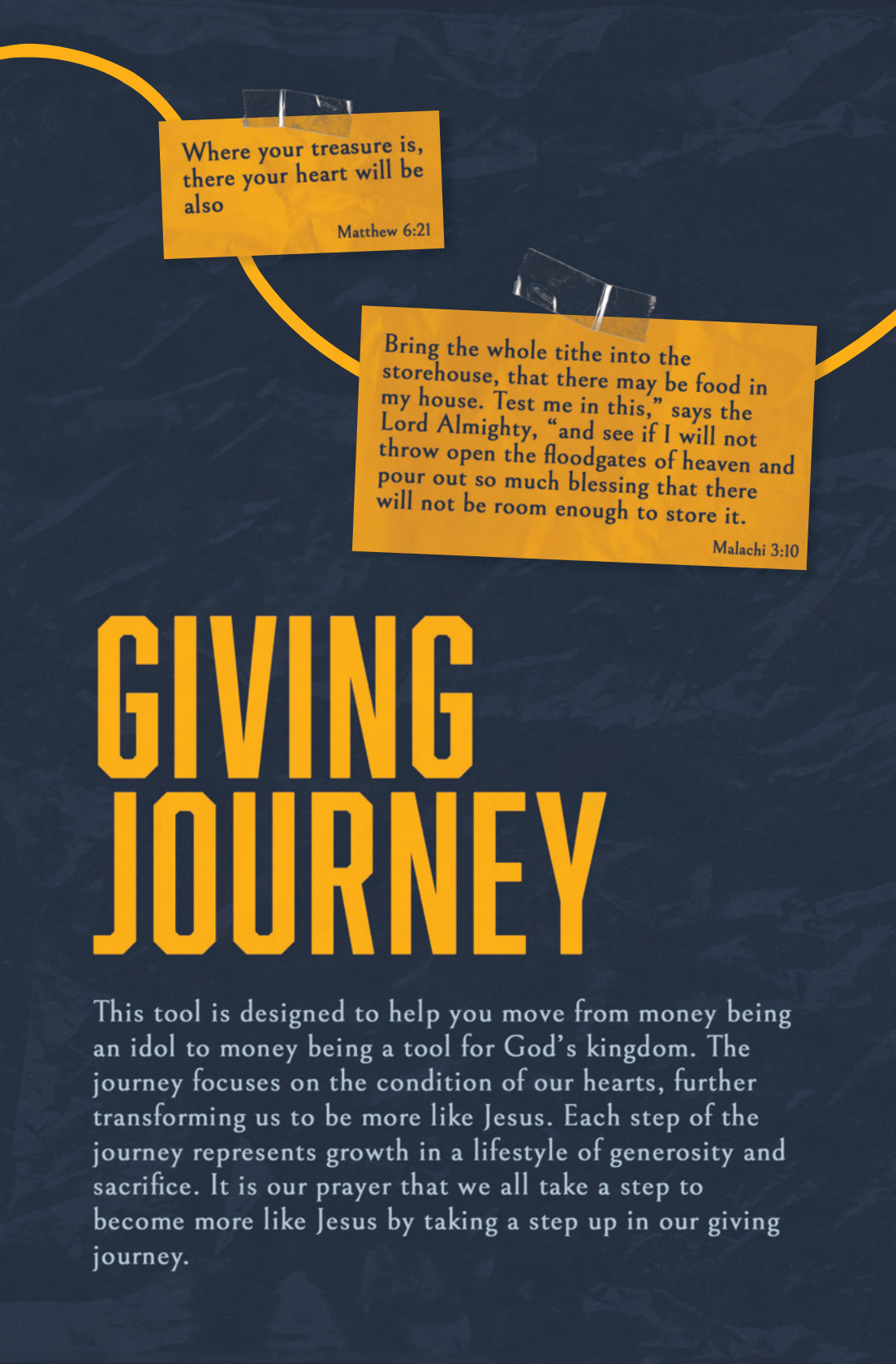

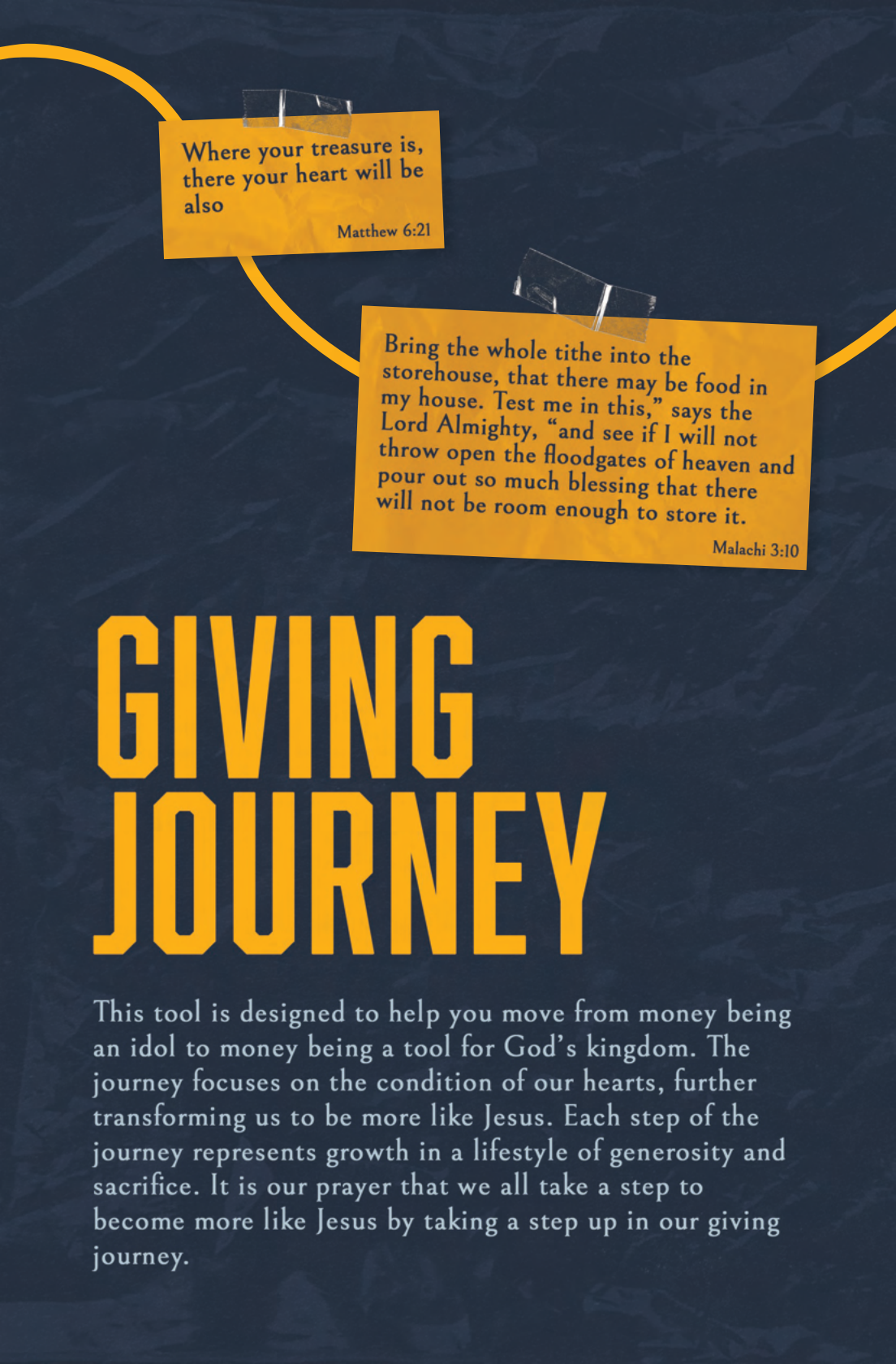
WATCH - Prepare to see how God works through us for His will to be done.

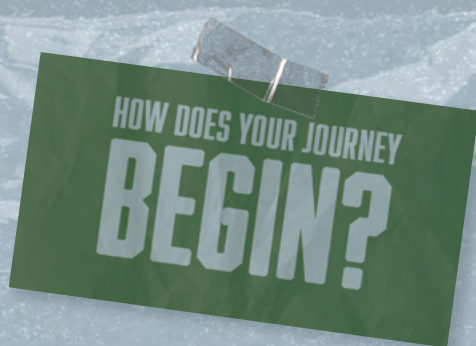

GIVING JOURNEY

This tool is designed to help you move from money being an idol to money being a tool for God's kingdom. The journey focuses on the condition of our hearts, further transforming us to be more like Jesus. Each step of the journey represents growth in a lifestyle of generosity and sacrifice. It is our prayer that we all take a step to become more like Jesus by taking a step up in our giving journey.

INITIAL GIVER

An Initial Giver is someone who decides to give for the first time out of a response to God's Word about giving. This is someone who decides to give something and trust God and the leaders of the church with this gift.



CONSISTENT GIVER

A Consistent Giver is someone who decides to give something on a consistent basis to exercise the discipline of giving. Someone who decides to make their gift recurring will be learning the behavior of consistency.

INTENTIONAL GIVER

An Intentional Giver is someone who thinks about their giving in relation to their other financial priorities. This giver starts to make their giving an intentional choice that reflects how they prioritize it in relation to other things on which they spend their money.

TRANSFORMED GIVER

A Transformed Giver is someone who recognizes the power of the gospel and is surrendered to honoring God with 100% of their resources as a result. They give in a way that changes them, reflecting that their giving is governing their spending /serving, rather than their spending/serving governing their giving. They seek to honor God with ALL He has given them, whether that means direct monetary giving or God-honoring use of an existing resource.

LEGACY GIVER

A Legacy Giver makes decisions in the short-term that have long-term effects as it relates to their generosity capacity. They think of what home they buy, what car they purchase, how much savings they choose to keep, all relative to their generosity capacity. A Legacy Giver is driven by the things of eternity, putting their hope in God and not in the things of this earth.

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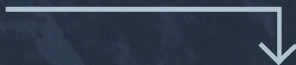
