### **BIG IDEA**

- Ice Breaker :: For those of you who grew up in church, what are some of your favorite memories from VBS or Sunday School?
- God protected baby Moses by having him found in a basket (called a Tevah, like Noah's Ark). How does the story of Moses show that God is always watching over us? Do you have any times from your life where you can look back and see God working things out for your good?
- Moses felt he wasn't good enough to lead the rescue of God's people. What is something God is asking you to do that you feel you aren't ready for? Can you think of a time where you did do what God was asking you to do?
- The plagues were "strategic acts of war" against Egypt's false gods. What are some things in our world that people worship or trust more than they trust God? How can we point them to Jesus?
- God told the Israelites to use the blood of a lamb to cover their doorframe so death would "pass over" them. The sermon says Jesus is our ultimate Passover Lamb. How does Jesus' blood protect us? Is your family covered by the blood?
