BIG IDEA

Two years ago we set out on a 2 year discipleship journey asking the question, "Are we willing to do Whatever It Takes to reach all of Jones County with the Gospel?"

Today, we celebrate the close of year one and step into year two where we press on doing whatever it takes to Build the Kingdom!

PRAYER

DISCUSSION

- We are going to look into 2 Corinthians 5:14-20 today to look at what Scripture teaches us about doing *whatever it takes* to know God and make God known.
- Read 2 Corinthians 5:14–20 in the New Living Translation
- Interpretation: Paul writes in verse 14 that we have died to our old life, and we no longer live for ourselves. If we are no longer living for ourselves, who are we living for? What does it mean to live for someone else?
- Interpretation: Paul writes in verse 17, "anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person." What do you think it means to become a new person in Christ? What has your life been like since giving your life to Christ?
- Application: God has given us a new life in Christ. What should we be doing in response to that? How are you specifically doing that right now in your life?
- Application: Whatever it takes is all about putting our yes on the table. Where is God asking for your yes but you are hesitant? How can we help you take a next step?

- Pray for the Kingdom of Heaven to reign in Jones County and beyond
- Pray for one another to continue taking next steps
- Pray for those who were just baptized and for those on the fence about taking that next step
