

# STRIPPING OF THE CHURCH

The stripping of the church has come to symbolize the stripping of Jesus before the Crucifixion. By the time of its conclusion the church's chancel is transformed from being a place of holy worship in the midst of beauty, to what now appears quite like a tomb. In that transformation, we see a great truth: the joy we typically experience in our worship came at the cost of the death of the One we worship.

#### **WHAT IS MAUNDY THURSDAY?**

Maundy Thursday is an alternate name for Holy Thursday, the first of the three days of solemn remembrance of the events leading up to and immediately following the crucifixion of Jesus. The English word "Maundy" comes from the Latin mandatum, which means "commandment." As recorded in John's gospel, on his last night before his betrayal and arrest, Jesus washed the feet of his disciples and then gave them a new commandment to love one another as he had loved them (John 13:34). This is why services on this night generally include the washing of feet, hands, or other acts of physical care as an integral partof the celebration. While John's gospel does not record the institution of the Lord's Supper among the events of this night, the other gospels do. This is why Christians have traditionally observed this night both at the basin (foot or hand washing) and at the Lord's Table (Holy Communion).

#### HOLY COMMUNION

We will share in the meal of bread and juice known as the Lord's Supper, Holy Communion, or The Eucharist. This meal was instituted by Christ as a means of grace for us to remember his great love for us, to be forgiven of our sins, and to be strengthened for our journey in life. This is not a United Methodist meal — it is the meal of Christ. Thus, all are welcome, including children, to come and participate in this gift from God.
