May 2026 Financial Update & June/July Summer Outlook

May ended with a positive cash flow of \$41,935. Thank you for your faithful support and generosity!

As we enter the summer months, we are reminded that this is traditionally our most challenging giving season. While offerings often decrease during the summer, our monthly expenses—utilities, salaries, ministry programs, and building operations—remain steady.

Your continued financial support helps keep our ministries active and our mission moving forward.

Council will be busy this summer preparing recommendations for presentation at our Annual Meeting on August 30.

Key topics include:

- Finalizing the August 2026–July 2027 budget;
- Evaluating whether to use additional Building Fund savings to reduce our mortgage balance before its January 1, 2027, renewal;
- Developing a financing plan for a new worship space roof, estimated to cost \$140,000.

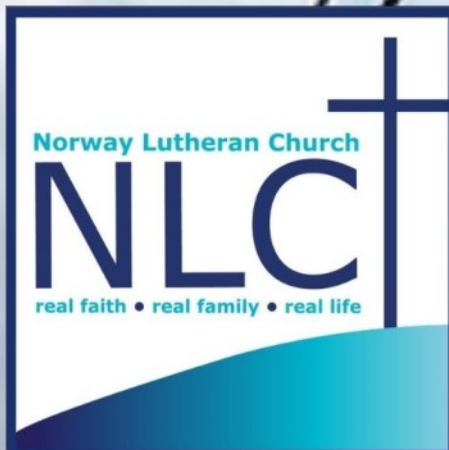
