Sermon – Pastor and Ashlynn

P Ashlynn, you have been baptized into the Holy Christian faith, you have spent time learning the basics of the Christian religion, and you have reached the age where others can no longer speak for you on matters of faith. Jesus said, in the 10th Chapter of Matthew; ***“Whoever confesses Me before men, I will also confess before My Father who is in heaven. But whoever denies Me before men, I will also deny before My Father who is in heaven.”*** Lift up your heart, therefore, to the God of all grace and joyfully give answer to what I now ask you in the name of the Lord.

P Do you this day in the presence of God and of this congregation acknowledge the gifts that God gave you in your Baptism?

R ***Yes, I do.***

P Do you renounce the devil?

R ***Yes, I renounce him.***

P Do you renounce all his works and all his ways?

R ***Yes, I renounce them.***

P Do you believe in God, the Father Almighty?

R ***Yes, I believe in God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth.***

P Do you believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord?

R ***Yes, I believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was***

crucified, died and was buried. He descended into hell. The third day he rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of God the Father Almighty. From thence he will come to judge the living and the dead.

P Do you believe in the Holy Spirit?

R ***Yes, I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Christian Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting.***

P Do you hold all the prophetic and apostolic Scriptures to be the inspired Word of God?

R ***I do.***

P Do you confess the doctrine of the Evangelical Lutheran Church, drawn from the Scriptures, as you have learned to know it from Luther's Small Catechism, to be faithful and true?

R ***I do.***

P Do you intend to hear the Word of God and receive the Lord's Supper faithfully?

R ***I do, by the grace of God.***

P Do you intend to live according to the Word of God, and in faith, word, and deed to remain true to God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, even to death?

R ***I do, by the grace of God.***

P Do you intend to continue steadfast in this confession and Faith and to suffer all, even death, rather than fall away from it?

R ***I do, by the grace of God.***

P Ashlynn, the almighty God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has given you the new birth of water and of the Spirit and has forgiven you all your sins, strengthen you with His grace to life T everlasting.



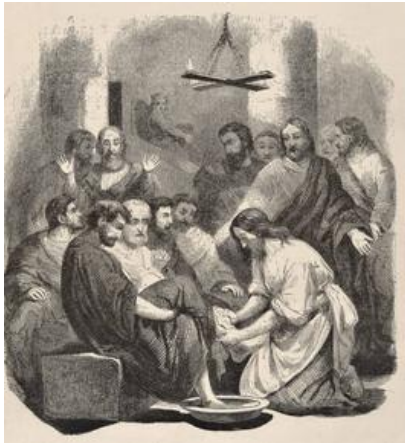
