Three ways on how to deal with sin: Reveal, Resist, and Rejoice.

1. _____ Sin. Proverbs 28:13 *“Whoever conceals his transgressions will not prosper, but he who confesses and forsakes them will obtain mercy.”*
2. _____ Sin. James 4:7 *“Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.”*
3. _____ in Salvation. Romans 6:23 *“For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.”*

The Gospel of Jesus Christ

The Gospel from the Greek word Euangelion means the good news that God created us for his glory (Isaiah 43:6-7), but we all have sinned and fallen short from his glory (Rom 3:23), for we deserve eternal death (Rom 6:23). However, in his mercy God created a plan for our salvation and sent his Son Jesus into the world to provide a way for eternal life (John 3:16).
