


Revelation 12 Discussion Guide, Feb 10-11, 2026: His Truth Triumphs Through Us

Gen 37:9-10 Then [Joseph] dreamed another dream and told it to his brothers and said, "Behold, I have dreamed another dream. Behold, the sun, the moon, and eleven stars were bowing down to me." But when he told it to his father [Jacob] and to his brothers, his father rebuked him and said to him, "What is this dream that you have dreamed? Shall I and your mother and your brothers indeed come to bow ourselves to the ground before you?"

Exodus 19:4 You yourselves have seen what I did to the Egyptians, and how I bore you [Israel] on eagles' wings and brought you to myself.
