Foundation Education Scholarships

POLICY STATEMENT:

The purpose of the Foundations Education Scholarship shall be to assist and encourage worthy individuals from churches affiliated with the Baptist Convention of New York to seek financial assistance for their college, graduate and/or post-graduate theological education. These individuals shall demonstrate a financial need, academic achievement and desire serve Christ through their future vocational. The applicant shall be a member in good standing of a Southern Baptist Church in the Baptist Convention of New York.

PROCEDURE:

1. The Educational Scholarships shall be prayerfully considered and administered by the Scholarship Committee of the BCNY Foundation.
2. All applications must be obtained online at www.bcnysbc.org and submitted to the Scholarship Committee no later than **March 31st** of the calendar year of projected college registration.
3. All applications must be completed in their entirety to be considered. Any category where information is unavailable, an explanation must be provided.

5. Scholarships will be awarded to students meritoriously at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee's evaluation of following criteria: personal testimony of faith in Christ, financial need, references, previous Christian service, academic achievement and ministry goals.
