Come Craft with Us! United Women in Faith Craft Circle 9 to 11 am Sept. 23, in Rooms 17/18 (Magee).

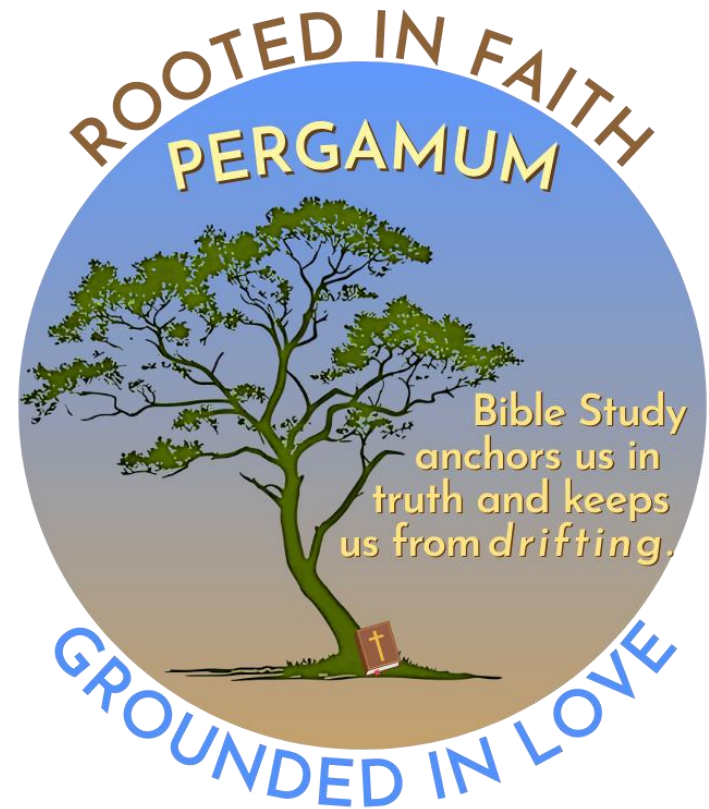
