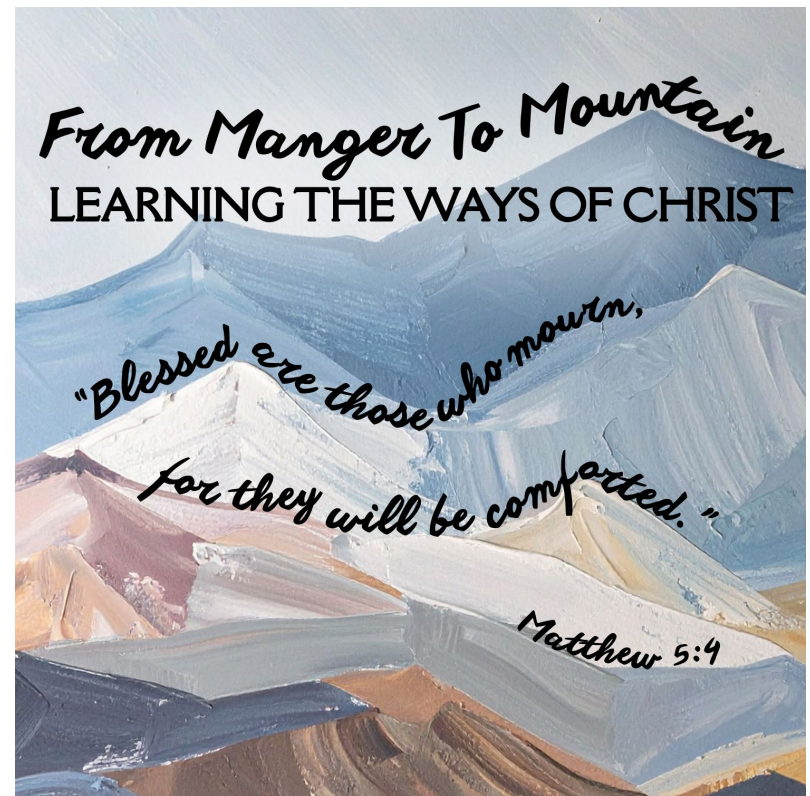
Custodian Wanted! We are hiring a custodian for 10 hours a week at the Magee Campus. Flexible hours. Contact Lora for more information or to apply.
