Crazy Cards is returning on Friday, March 6 at 6:30 pm in the Magee Campus Fellowship Hall. \$5 per person when you sign up.


Market on the Move Saturday, March 7 from 8 am-10 am Magee Campus. Come in the La Canada entrance. \$10 for 60# of produce.
