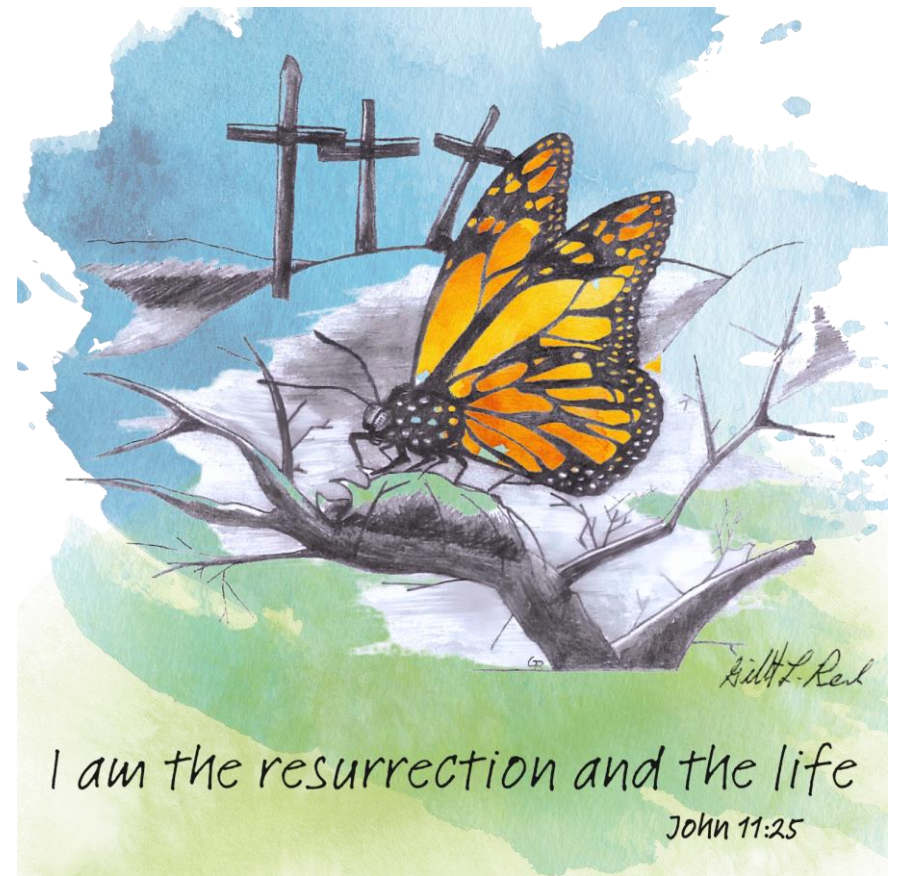
Sunday Concert Series presents a 4-Hand piano concert at **3 pm on Sunday, April 12** in the sanctuary.
