While the Lenten fast lasts forty days (not including Sundays), the Easter feast lasts fifty. As Jesus said, fasting will pass away (*Matt 9:15*), but the Great Feast of the Lamb is eternal. Let the feasting begin!

Intercessor: For all who are in danger, sorrow, or any kind of trouble;

People: For those who minister to the sick, the friendless, and the needy.

Intercessor: For the peace and unity of the Church of God;

People: For all who proclaim the Gospel, and all who seek the Truth.

Intercessor: For Sean our Presiding Bishop, and for all bishops and other ministers;

People: For all who serve God in his Church.

Intercessor: We pray to you also for the forgiveness of our sins.

**People: Have mercy upon us, most merciful Father;
in your compassion forgive us our sins,
known and unknown,
things done and left undone;
and so uphold us by your Spirit
that we may live and serve you in newness of life,
to the honor and glory of your Name;
through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.**

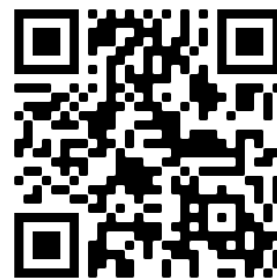
