#### ORDINARY TIME

The long season of Ordinary Time, or "the Season after Pentecost", highlights the work of the Holy Spirit in the mission of the church. Given this focus on the now and coming kingdom, some have called this season "kingdomtide."

Ordinary Time begins with Trinity Sunday and contains another principal feast, All Saints (Nov 1), the ancient remembrance of those who gave their lives for the faith. Also known as "the season of the church," it wraps up with the modern addition to the liturgical calendar, Christ the King Sunday, a reminder that we have a King and it is not us.



#### OLD TESTAMENT 1 Chronicles 29:6-20

<sup>6</sup> Then the leaders of families, the officers of the tribes of Israel, the commanders of thousands and commanders of hundreds, and the officials in charge of the king's work gave willingly. <sup>7</sup> They gave toward the work on the temple of God five thousand talents and ten thousand darics of gold, ten thousand talents of silver, eighteen thousand talents of bronze and a hundred thousand talents of iron. <sup>8</sup> Anyone who had precious stones gave them to the treasury of the temple of the Lord in the custody of Jehiel the Gershonite. <sup>9</sup> The people rejoiced at the willing response of their leaders, for they had given freely and wholeheartedly to the Lord. David the king also rejoiced greatly.

<sup>10</sup> David praised the Lord in the presence of the whole assembly, saying,



"Praise be to you, Lord, the God of our father Israel, from everlasting to everlasting.

<sup>11</sup> Yours, Lord, is the greatness and the power and the glory and the majesty and the splendor, for everything in heaven and earth is yours.

Yours, Lord, is the kingdom; you are exalted as head over all.

<sup>12</sup> Wealth and honor come from you; you are the ruler of all things.

In your hands are strength and power to exalt and give strength to all.

<sup>13</sup> Now, our God, we give you thanks, and praise your glorious name.

<sup>14</sup> "But who am I, and who are my people, that we should be able to give as generously as this? Everything comes from you, and we have given you only what comes from your hand. <sup>15</sup> We are foreigners and strangers in your sight, as were all our ancestors. Our days on earth are like a shadow, without hope. <sup>16</sup> Lord our God, all this abundance that we have provided for building you a temple for your Holy Name comes from your hand, and all of it belongs to you. <sup>17</sup> I know, my God, that you test the heart and are pleased with integrity. All these things I have given willingly and with honest intent. And now I have seen with joy how willingly your people who are here have given to you. <sup>18</sup> Lord, the God of our fathers Abraham, Isaac and Israel, keep these desires and thoughts in the hearts of your people forever, and keep their hearts loyal to you. <sup>19</sup> And give my son Solomon the wholehearted devotion to keep your commands, statutes and decrees and to do everything to build the palatial structure for which I have provided."

<sup>20</sup> Then David said to the whole assembly, "Praise the Lord your God." So they all praised the Lord, the God of their fathers; they bowed down, prostrating themselves before the Lord and the king.

#### **PSALM** *Psalm* 37:1-10

- <sup>1</sup> Do not fret yourself because of evildoers; \* do not be jealous of those who do wrong.
- <sup>2</sup> For they shall soon wither like the grass, \* and like the green grass fade away.
- <sup>3</sup> Put your trust in the Lord and do good; \* dwell in the land and feed on its riches.
- <sup>4</sup> Take delight in the Lord, \* and he shall give you your heart's desire.
- <sup>5</sup> Commit your way to the Lord and put your trust in him, \* and he will bring it to pass.
- 6 He will make your righteousness as clear as the light \* and your just dealing as the noonday.
- <sup>7</sup> Be still before the Lord \* and wait patiently for him.
- 8 Do not fret yourself over the one who prospers, \* the one who succeeds in evil schemes.
- <sup>9</sup> Refrain from anger, leave rage alone; \* do not fret yourself; it leads only to evil.
- 10 For evildoers shall be cut off, \*
  but those who wait upon the Lord shall possess the land.


#### NEW TESTAMENT 2 Timothy 1:7-10

<sup>7</sup> For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline. <sup>8</sup> So do not be ashamed of the testimony about our Lord or of me his prisoner. Rather, join with me in suffering for the gospel, by the power of God. <sup>9</sup> He has saved us and called us to a holy life—not because of anything we have done but because of his own purpose and grace. This grace was given us in Christ Jesus before the beginning of time, <sup>10</sup> but it has now been revealed through the appearing of our Savior, Christ Jesus, who has destroyed death and has brought life and immortality to light through the gospel.

#### THE GOSPEL Luke 18:18-30

Celebrant: The Holy Gospel + of our Lord Jesus Christ according

to Luke.

People: Glory to you, Lord Christ.

<sup>18</sup> A certain ruler asked him, "Good teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?"

<sup>19</sup> "Why do you call me good?" Jesus answered. "No one is good—except God alone. <sup>20</sup> You know the commandments: 'You shall not commit adultery, you shall not murder, you shall not steal, you shall not give false testimony, honor your father and mother.'"

<sup>21</sup> "All these I have kept since I was a boy," he said.

<sup>22</sup> When Jesus heard this, he said to him, "You still lack one thing. Sell everything you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me."



- <sup>23</sup> When he heard this, he became very sad, because he was very wealthy. <sup>24</sup> Jesus looked at him and said, "How hard it is for the rich to enter the kingdom of God! <sup>25</sup> Indeed, it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for someone who is rich to enter the kingdom of God."
- <sup>26</sup> Those who heard this asked, "Who then can be saved?"
- <sup>27</sup> Jesus replied, "What is impossible with man is possible with God."
- <sup>28</sup> Peter said to him, "We have left all we had to follow you!"
- <sup>29</sup> "Truly I tell you," Jesus said to them, "no one who has left home or wife or brothers or sisters or parents or children for the sake of the kingdom of God <sup>30</sup> will fail to receive many times as much in this age, and in the age to come eternal life."

#### NICENE CREED

to the glory of your Name. Amen.

The Celebrant declares God's pardon and absolution.

The people extend God's peace to one another.



People: We lift them up to the Lord.


Celebrant: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.


People: It is right to give him thanks and praise.

All baptized Christians are welcome to receive holy communion. Please let an usher know if you need to have communion brought to you.


Gluten free wafers are available upon request.

#### POST COMMUNION PRAYER


