Directions: Read the following questions carefully. Give yourself time to think about them. You need not answer all the questions, nor is there a correct answer to each.

1. What cause, idea, people group, area of ministry, etc., do you feel strongly about and care deeply about?

2. If God granted you one wish regarding what you would like to do for the rest of your life, what would it be?

3. What are some of the pressing needs in ministry that have caught your attention and keep popping up in your mind?

4. Do you have a “burning conviction” that a certain ministry is the most important place where God would have you? If so, what is it?



5. Do your spiritual gifts point you in a particular vocational direction?

6. Do you have a “burning, gut-level desire” to reach a particular group of people such as the lost, unchurched, unborn, biblically illiterate, oppressed, children, adults, youth, homosexuals, single parents, singles, street gangs, military, ethnic groups, etc. If so, who are they?

7. Do you have a strong desire to pursue a particular issue as your ministry? Do any of the following causes stir your emotions: The family, divorce, drug abuse, physical or emotional abuse, alcoholism, civil rights, politics, women’s rights, poverty, starving children, legalism, clarity of the gospel, pro-life, etc.?

8. Does the pursuit of a particular topic excite you? Do any of the following attract you: Apologetics, cults, theology, the Bible, the law, business, leadership, politics, government, finances, the arts, strategic thinking, etc.?



9. Do you find yourself strongly attracted to a particular geographical area of ministry such as an urban, suburban, or rural area located in a specific city, county, state, or foreign country? If so, where?

10. Do you have an attraction to a particular area of ministry in the church such as leading a small group, teaching a class or on a topic, preaching a sermon, ministering to a particular age group? If so, what?

11. If money, family, and time were not factors, what would you want to do for the rest of your life?

12. Do you have a secret desire or ambition, something that you've always wanted to do but were afraid to tell anyone? If so, what is it?



13. Is there anyone whom you admire and would like to do what they do, such as a professor, teacher, pastor, evangelist, preacher, leader, administrator, manager, consultant, trainer, church planter, church revitalizer, etc.?
