PASTOR'S MOMENT:

On Wednesday nights we are beginning to look at the lives of the Patriarchs in Genesis. These sections of Scripture are some of my favorites. The study of the historical background and culture is truly fascinating. We often stand in awe of the strong faith displayed by these early biblical characters. They did not have the advantages that we have today of written Scripture and millennia of tradition. In looking through these stories, we often overlook an important detail. That detail is just how radically different they were from the cultures around them.

In our Christian walk, it is always a balancing act in how to relate to the wider culture around us, and yet be markedly different. If we go to the extreme, then we alienate people and lose the opportunity to interact with them. If we are not different enough, then we blend into the culture and no one can tell the difference. We can learn from the lives of the Patriarchs, particularly Joseph, how to live in a culture that is growing less religious and still be different enough to be recognized. Our character, morals, values, and love of Christ must always shine through and point people to the gospel.

Kevin and Victoria serve as International Mission Board (IMB) missionaries in Uganda among Sudanese refugees. Their primary work is doing food distribution, trauma healing, and evangelism alongside discipleship. As a result of the food distributions and sharing the gospel, Kevin explained, "We have a small church plant whose leaders are Muslim-background believers [who] passionately seek to evangelize their lost Sudanese brothers and sisters." Kevin's team members also seek to provide long-term help for refugees through a ministry of training people in small business management.


