I tell you that in the same way, there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who need no repentance. Luke 15:7

In Luke 15, Jesus teaches three parables that focus on seeking that which is lost. At the end of each parable, there is great rejoicing that what was lost has been found. Great value had been placed upon that which was lost, and a diligent effort had been made to search for it. Even though others might not have thought that one sheep or one coin was significant, it did not diminish the importance of finding it for the seeker.

It is vital for Christians today not to lose sight of the significance of searching diligently for those who are lost. We often direct our efforts to other ventures and forget the commission that Jesus gave to all of us. There is often little rejoicing when the lost are saved because we have not been diligently searching. When a sinner comes to repentance after much prayer, much seeking, and many shed tears, the joy is overwhelming. I pray that we rejoice greatly when one is saved because we have searched diligently. 
