PASTOR'S MOMENT:

And now these three remain: faith, hope and love. But the greatest of these is love. (1 Corinthians 13:13)

Love is a multi-faceted word that gets much attention this time of year. Just as we use the word love in many different contexts with different meanings, the Greek New Testament does as well. When the Bible speaks of Christlike love, it uses the word agape. This is the type of love that Christ has for us and the type of love that we should have for each other.

There is an acrostic that describes this type of love well: S.C.A.R. A scar is a noticeable mark that usually comes from a memorable or life-changing event. It makes a difference and doesn't go away. When someone has experienced the agape love of Christ, it leaves a mark on them that doesn't go away.

Christlike love is:

Sacrificial

Committed

Accepting

Redemptive

It is important for us as believers who have experienced this type of love to show it to others. We exhibit this type of love so others can see and experience Christlike love and hopefully choose to have a saving relationship with Him.
