A NOTE FROM OUR DEACON CHAIR:

What a great time to be a part of First Baptist Church Jefferson! Sunday school classes are growing, Wednesday night attendance has been very good and it's great to see the sanctuary full again. The average attendance for February 2023 was 103 and the average attendance for February 2024 was 154. Our sanctuary, including the balcony, will comfortably seat 161, not including the choir loft and leaving the first two pews for the children. We all want to stay together in one service and still have room to grow. For those comfortable in doing so, we would like to ask our members to fill the sanctuary from front to back. This would leave any extra space for late arrivals and give visitors more options.

This weekend will be a busy time for our church. On Saturday, March 9th, we are privileged to host Sandra Beeco's nephew, Andres Beeco, as he produces and directs a short film in our church. The film, "More Than Worth It", is family friendly and echoes the parable of the Good Samaritan. Its purpose is to encourage the return of traditional Christian morals and values to our country. Pastor Matt has read and approved the script and the Deacons have approved the use of the sanctuary.

This Sunday, immediately following the 11:00 service, a Discover FBCJ luncheon will be held in the Fellowship Hall. The luncheon is for new and prospective church members. A meal will be served, and childcare will be provided. Staff and other leaders of the church will talk about church structure, as well as various ministries and opportunities to serve at FBCJ. The Deacons met this past Sunday and unanimously voted to have two services on Easter Sunday, March 31. The attendance for Easter Sunday last year was 166 and based on the past couple of months we are expecting attendance to exceed 200.

Children's Ministries: March Children in Action: This month during Children in Action the children will learn about Aimee Stucke, Geneva Initiative Coordinator for the Send Relief Boston. They will discover how Aimee recruits, trains, and helps churches and volunteers care for and support refugees resettling in the Greater Boston Area.
