

Discussion Questions – Kingdom Priorities

1. Jesus warns against storing up treasures on earth. What are some “treasures” people pursue today that are fleeting? How can we shift our focus toward eternal treasures instead?

2. Jesus teaches that treasures in heaven are eternal. What are some examples of “heavenly treasures” we can pursue in our lives?

3. Jesus says, “Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.” How do the things we value reveal the condition of our hearts?

4. Jesus uses the illustration of the eye to describe focus. What kinds of things distract believers from keeping their focus on God’s kingdom?

5. Why is it impossible to serve both God and money? How can wealth or possessions begin to master someone’s life?

6. Jesus says worry cannot add a single hour to our lives. What are some common worries Christians struggle with today? How does trusting God change the way we handle those worries?

7. Matthew 6:33 says, "Seek first His kingdom and His righteousness." What does seeking the kingdom first look like in your daily life?
